

# Jack Russell Terrier Puppy Recording

The Jack Russell Terrier Club of Canada (JRTCC) administers a Puppy Recording system for Jack Russell Terriers (Parson Jack Russell Terrier). The Puppy Recording system has been designed specifically to provide the breeders of Jack Russell Terriers with a system where they can pre-submit the basic data required to register/record a Jack Russell Terrier with the JRTCC. In return the Breeder (JRTCC member) will receive a Puppy Recording Certificate which can be transferred to the puppy Buyer. The certificate provides the Buyer with a discount on the fee to register/record their terrier, protects the Puppy's name (if submitted, see requirements below) for a period of time and indicates that the Breeder has submitted to the JRTCC a completed Pedigree and Stud Service Certificate.

To record a terrier puppy the Breeder must complete the following application, provide the applicable forms, required fee and send the package to the JRTCC Registration Office. The forms will be checked for completeness. All records on the recorded puppy will be kept on file the same as for the registry, and a **Certificate of Puppy Recording** will be issued.

The Puppy Recording Certificate **does not** guarantee that this puppy will be acceptable for registration with the JRTCC (once it turns a year of age), nor does it certify the health or quality of the puppy. The certificate does not replace the JRTCC adult Registration or Recording certificates and can not be used as a substitute certificate where the JRTCC requires the Terrier to be registered or recorded.

If there are any errors or missing documentation from the puppy recording application the Registrar will inform the Breeder and the Breeder has 60 days to correct and/or supply the required documentation or the application will be closed, the application fee forfeit, and the Breeder will have to resubmit the entire application.

The Puppy Recording Certificate will be printed and signed by the Registrar. When the puppy is sold, the Breeder is to enter the Buyers information and counter sign the certificate. This Certificate will act as the terrier's as proof of Puppy Recording.

Once signed by the Breeder this certificate is redeemable for \$10 (Can.) off a JRTCC registration/recording for the listed terrier. In order to receive the discount this certificate must accompany a completed JRTCC Registration/Recording Application. The application will not require a signed Pedigree or Stud Service Certificate as these papers are already on file for this terrier. The \$10 can be deducted from the required registration/recording fee.

### Application Requirements

1. The Sire and Dam must be registered with the JRTCC or JRTCA.
2. Breeder must be a current member of the Jack Russell Terrier Club of Canada, and signatory to the Breeders Code of Ethics, before the Jack Russell Terrier puppy(ies) will be recorded.
3. Each application **MUST** include:
  - a) **Application Form** completed in full and signed, one copy for each puppy.
  - b) **Puppy's Name (optional)**. If a name is provided for the puppy, and it meets the requirements, it will be used. The name will become the recorded name for that puppy for a period of two years from birth. If the terrier is not adult registered/recorded by the time it reaches its second birthday the name will be released to be available for use by another Terrier. If the Breeder of the puppy has a JRTCC and/or JRTCA registered kennel name, that name will be used as the prefix for the puppy's name and will be printed on the certificate. If the first choice name (combination of kennel name and Breeder's selected name) is already used as a JRTCC registered/recorded name then the second choice will be checked for conflict, if both names are already registered/recorded with the JRTCC then the Breeder will be asked to supply two more choices. Suffixes (ie: current owners's kennel name) are will not be included in the puppy's recorded name.
  - c) **Stud Service Certificate** must be completed and signed (original signature only) by owner of **Sire** at time of breeding, one copy for each puppy.
  - d) **Pedigree** must be legible and include the following: the puppy's name (if provided), the puppy's whelping date, the full names of the terriers listed, details of parents and grand parents (height, coat, colour, breeders name, breeding location, and JRTCC and/or JRTCA registration/recording numbers if available), the breeders name and full address, and be signed (original signature only) and dated by the breeder. The Puppy Recording Certificate will list the parents with their data, so include their data to make your certificates complete. *(Do not send individual pedigrees of your puppies sire and dam.)*
  - i) **Registration Fee:** \$5 for each puppy or \$25 for 5 or more puppies. (cheque or money order made payable to the JRTCC, no cash please).
