

Jack Russell Terrier Club of Canada



Photo directions are for “recording” your terrier with the JRTCC.

Four (4) Photographs, taken in colour, of the terrier standing on a level hard surface with the feet visible. The photographs are to be of two (2) different left views and two (2) different right views. The photographs must portray the terrier in a natural position. Outdoor shots are preferable with good contrast between terrier and the background. *(Due to the Certificate laminating process, polaroid photos or photos produced on home printers are not acceptable.)*

Fill the frame ie: get the terrier as large as possible in the picture. Take pictures at the terrier’s level, rather than from above or downward angle. Do not photograph the terrier standing in grass as the paws are not visible. All four paws must be on the same level surface

Do not tape or staple photographs to page. Do not cut photographs.

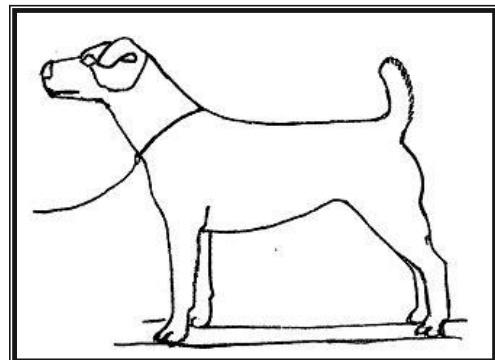
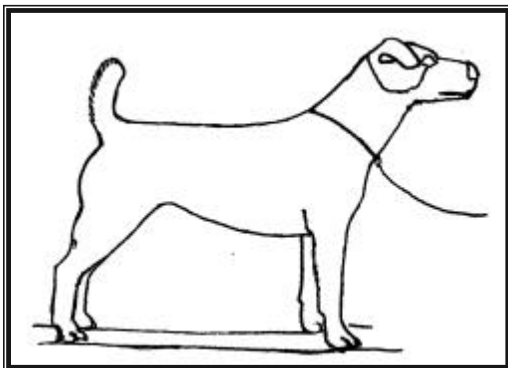
