

FOR CURRENT JRTCC MEMBERS

What You Need To Know About 'JRT Bucks'

- 1) The recipient of '*JRT Bucks*' must be a **current** JRTCC member whose name has been written on a **new** applicant's membership form in the space provided.
i.e. *Referral by:* _____
The new member's application must be for a single **or** family voting membership.
- 2) Qualifying members will be contacted **by email** as soon as possible after the JRTCC National Trial. The total of '*JRT Bucks*' earned by the member will be included in the email.
- 3) **If** the intention of the recipient is to redeem the earned '*JRT Bucks*' when renewing the current year's membership, that deduction may be made to the membership fee. The recipient should note somewhere on the form that '*JRT Bucks*' are being redeemed. Along with any balance of dues, the completed/signed membership form should be submitted to the JRTCC at the address provided on the form.
The maximum benefit to the current member will be a maximum of **one** single (\$40) or family (\$45) voting membership.

⇒ The **\$5 Early Bird** reduction may also be used if the membership is postmarked by December 31st!

⇒ *Unused 'JRT Bucks' may not be carried over to the following membership year. 'JRT Bucks' have no other cash value.*
- 4) 'JRT Bucks' earned from a new membership application will be credited to only one current JRTCC member.
