- ☑ ***All Entries must be received no later than Saturday, August 18th.*** WE WILL CONFIRM RECEIPT OF YOUR ENTRY BY EMAIL. IF YOU HAVE NOT RECEIVED CONFIRMATION OF RECEIPT BY June 11th, PLEASE CONTACT THE TRIAL SECRETARY Email: spaas001@yahoo.ca or telephone: 519-448-4357
- ☑ Entry fees are \$10 per class for current JRTCC members and \$12 per class for non JRTCC members. Full payment must accompany entry form.
- ☑ Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. Any exhibitor showing a bitch in season will be excused from ALL classes, with no refunds.
- ☑ **Puppies under 4 months of age are not permitted on the trial grounds.** Any exhibitor with puppies under 4 months of age on the trial grounds will be excused from ALL classes, with no refunds.

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EXHIBITOR TO BE ON TIME FOR EVERY CLASS AND TO BE AWARE OF THE SCHEDULED CLASSES IN EACH DIVISION. **NO REFUNDS FOR MISSED CLASSES.**

Rules of the Competition

General

1. All classes are open to Jack Russell terriers only.
2. Terriers entered **MUST** be within the 10-15" height standard. (Exception: pups who have not yet reached 10".) Measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
3. A terrier bred by a sanctioned judge may not be shown under that judge at any sanctioned trial.
4. A question concerning the height of a terrier may be made only by another exhibitor in that class or by the judge. The measurement will be decided by the judge and considered the official height of the terrier in question for the duration of the trial. Requests made by spectators will not be honored. Height cards will be accepted where the terrier was measured at not less than 18 months old.
5. Classes may be split or combined if entries warrant.
6. Unsportsmanlike behavior on the part of competitors will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site and **NO** entry fees will be refunded.

Racing

1. All terriers over 6 months must be muzzled. Muzzles must be those approved by the JRTCC (i.e., basket muzzles or "softies").
2. Exhibitors must have terriers ready to race, be aware of their classes and be ready when called. No refunds will be given for missed races.
3. Once terriers are loaded into the starting gate, all handlers must proceed to the finish line and be ready to receive their terriers. Failure to pick up the terrier promptly may subject the entry to disqualification.
4. Terriers going around the jumps will be disqualified.
5. Any terrier that starts a fight in any race will be disqualified by the judge from further racing that day.
6. If the lure is caught, the race will be re-run.
7. Entries must cross the finish line completely to place in a race. The finish line is the **BACK** side of the barrier hay bales. First to the hole is not necessarily first through the hole.
8. Decisions of the judge are final.
9. Racing Champions (taken from flats & hurdles) are determined by a run-off of the first place terrier in each class in each division. Run-off races will be held over Hurdles.
10. All height measurement requests must be requested prior to the running of the heat/race, and only by an owner/handler of the terrier in that heat/race. **HEIGHT CARDS ARE ACCEPTED WHERE THE TERRIER WAS MEASURED AT NOT LESS THAN 18 MONTHS OLD.**
11. Novice Class are open to terriers, who have never competed before in racing. This class may be divided by height depending on entry numbers. There is no cross entering between novice and regular classes.

Lure Coursing

1. Terriers to be run individually.
2. Terriers are scored individually based on time. Seconds are added for going off course or cutting corners.
3. No cross entries.
4. Novice Class are open to terriers who have never competed before in lure coursing. Maybe divided by height depending on entry numbers. There is no cross entering between novice and regular classes.

Go-to-Ground

1. Schooling prior to the competition is NOT permitted. Any violation of this rule shall result in disqualification of the schooling terrier from go-to-ground competition at this trial. No entry fees will be refunded.
2. Exhibitors are responsible for collecting their terrier's score sheets at the secretary's stand and, at the time of the competition, to take them to the Den Steward for scoring by the judge.
3. Exhibitors should read the score sheets carefully as they contain important information regarding the requirements and judging criteria for each class.
4. The starting line shall be placed two feet from the entrance hole. Timing starts when the terrier is released. The terrier is to be released only when all four feet are on the ground at the starting line and may not be pushed or thrown towards the hole by its owner. Any violation of this rule, accidental or intentional, shall result in disqualification of the terrier from the class in which the violation occurs. No entry fees will be refunded.
5. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to collect the score sheet after the judging is complete.
6. To obtain a Trial Certificate after scoring 100% in the Open Class, the owner of the terrier must submit a copy of the qualifying score sheet, along with a \$15.00 filing fee to JRTCC Judges Committee, 20 Craigmere Crescent, Toronto, ON, M2N 2Y3.

Puissance Jumping

1. Terriers are split by height i.e. small & tall.
2. Terriers will compete by jumping over set jump heights. As a terrier successfully completes a set height, the jump is raised 2". Terriers continue on until they miss a height.
3. The terrier to successfully complete the highest jump will be awarded 1st place.
4. Classes may be done on or off lead.

Ball Retrieval

1. A line is marked off at 50 feet. Ball must be tossed over the line.
2. There are 2 throws per entry. Final score is taken from best time.

Run-off of first place winners of classes 104, 106, 117, 119
- Class 129: **TALL RACING CHAMPION & RESERVE**
Run-off of first place winners of classes 105, 107, 118, 120
- Class 130: **VETERAN RACING CHAMPION & RESERVE**
Run-off of first place winners of classes 110, 111, 123, 124

Division B ~ Go to Ground

- Class 200: **Pre-Novice Puppy – 4 to 6 months old.** *Entry in this class does not affect pups eligibility to enter Novice class after 6 months of age.* One (1) minute to reach quarry; mark for 15 seconds; may leave earth and re-enter.
- Class 201: **Novice Puppy**—open to terriers 6 months or older that have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCC trial. One minute to reach quarry. May leave earth and re-enter several times. Work quarry for 30 seconds.
- Entries earning a score of 100% in Novice Puppy at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter Open Puppy class at this trial.*
- Class 202: **Open Puppy**—open to terriers 6 up to 12 months that have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCC trial. Not open to any puppies that have previously achieved 100% in this class. 30 seconds to reach quarry. May leave earth once and re-enter. Work quarry for one minute
- Class 203: **Puppy Championship**—open to terriers 6 months up to 12 months that have scored 100% in an Open Go-to-Ground class at a previous JRTCC trial. *A copy of a 100% Open score sheet or Certificate must be submitted with entry.* 30 seconds to reach quarry. May leave earth once and re-enter. Work quarry for one minute
- Class 204: **Novice Adult** - open to terriers one year or older that have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCC trial. One minute to reach quarry. May leave earth and re-enter several times. Work quarry for 30 seconds.
- Entries earning a score of 100% in Novice Adult at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Class at this trial.*
- Class 205: **Open Adult 10-12.5"** - Open to Terriers one year or older that have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCC trial. 30 seconds to reach quarry. May leave earth once and re-enter. Work quarry for one minute.
- Class 206: **Open Adult 12.5-15"** - Open to Terriers one year or older that have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCC trial. 30 seconds to reach quarry. May leave earth once and re-enter. Work quarry for one minute.
- Note: Cross-entering is not permitted between the Championship Certificate and Veteran Certificate classes. A copy of the JRTCC Trial Certificate or 100% score sheet must accompany entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class.*
- Class 207: **Small Terrier 10-12.5" Championship Certificate** - open to terriers one year and older that hold a JRTCC Trial Certificate. 30 seconds to reach quarry. May not leave earth. Work quarry for one minute
- Class 208: **Tall Terrier 12.5-15" Championship Certificate** - open to terriers one year and older that hold a JRTCC Trial Certificate. 30 seconds to reach quarry. May not leave earth. Work quarry for one minute
- Class 209: **Veteran Certificate** - open to terriers 6 years of age or older that hold a JRTCC Trial Certificate. 30 seconds to reach quarry. May not leave earth. Work quarry for one minute
- Class 210: **Child/Junior Handler** – Terrier to be run through Novice tunnel. Judged on the child's handling of the terrier and knowledge of the event.

Division C ~ Lure Coursing

This is a timed event, judged on timing, form, and ability to follow the lure.
